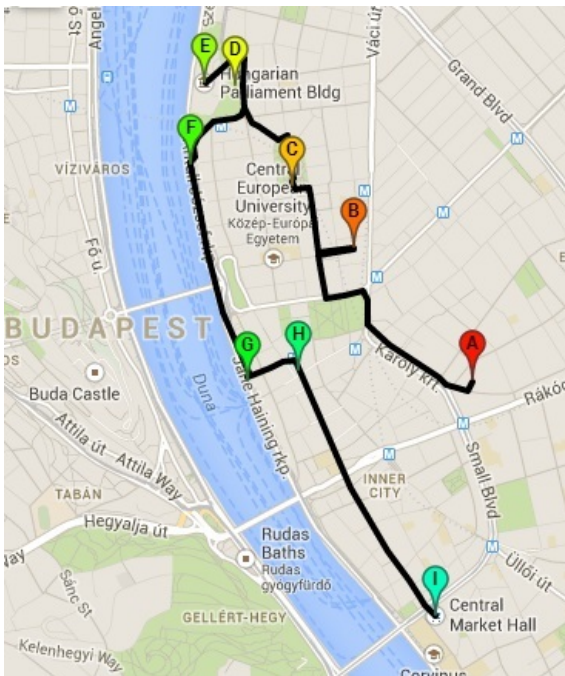

Hours: Open 10am-4pm most of the year. Open 10am-6pm in peak season. Closed on Saturdays. (You might want to verify hours for the time of year you are in town.)

Try to leave by 9:30am so you can get to Dohany Street Synagogue (also called the Great Synagogue) and its Tree of Life exhibit at 10am when it opens.

The Great Synagogue is the biggest in Europe. The interior is beautifully ornate. Outside is the Tree of Life which looks like a weeping willow tree, but when you look closer it is an upside down menorah. On each leaf is the name of a Holocaust victim.
