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### Ibiza on a Budget - Three-Day Itinerary

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# Day 1

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am -- Breakfast at Croissant Playa 9:30

- Price: EUR €8.00 (for a single adult)
- Duration: 30 minutes
- Address: C/ Pais Basc, Figueretes

Start your day with a delicious breakfast within the sound of the sea.

Croissant Playa, in Figueretes, is a cosy hole-in-the-wall between a souvenir shop and a bus stop that offers a sea view and serves fresh French pastries, quiche, toasted baguettes, fresh juice and coffee. The charming couple who run it will be happy to answer your questions about the island, point you in the direction of Playa d'en Bossa, or make you a sandwich to take away.

#### 10:00 am -- Walk to Playa d'en Bossa and take the ferry to Ibiza Town

- Price: EUR €3.50 (for a single adult)
- Duration: 1 hour



After breakfast you can catch the Aqua Bus from Figueretes or Playa d'en Bossa to Ibiza Town. To reach it, walk a few yards down to the promenade that runs along Figueretes beach. There is a well-marked Aqua Bus stop about 30 metres along, however, if you'd like to see more of the island I recommend walking to the next stop in the neighbouring resort town of Playa d'en Bossa.

Not only will you have a chance to enjoy the fresh air and work off your breakfast, but this is a quirky area full of raffish charm. Along the way you'll encounter an eclectic mix of workers on their way home from all-night shifts, pensioners walking tiny dogs, joggers, sunburnt tourists, and families heading to the beach.

After about five minutes, the promenade ends. Bear left and join the road that runs parallel to the sea. Continue walking past the neon-lit Art Deco façade of Hotel Es Vive on your right, and a run of flats and holiday apartments on the left.

Another five minutes brings you to a junction – the road curves right but continue walking past the front entrance of the Hotel Torre del Mar on your left and its tennis courts on the right. This leads you onto Playa d'en Bossa beach.

A couple of hundred yards ahead is the Aqua Bus stop <u>www.aquabusferryboats.com</u>. This little open-top white boat runs between Playa d'en Bossa and the port in Ibiza Town every 15 minutes between 10AM-6PM in May, June and Sept; and between 6AM-2AM in July and August. The journey takes 30 minutes and you get a spectacular view
